<p>The summer school in Gotland and the course on Geocomputation, both planned for the summer, were cancelled due to corona restrictions in place and inability of one of the teachers of the Geocomputation course to travel to Sweden.</p> <p>Two courses are planned to start in November: Managing the Anthropocene and eScience Tools in Climate Change. Six to seven student applications have been received for each course. The applications are from the department of Physical Geography, Geological Sciences, ACES, MISU, SRC and Lund University by the collaboration with ClimBEco research school. It was noted that there was no application from the Biological Science departments.</p> <p>The Advisory Group approved to offer the course on Climate Science with contributions of each Research Area in the spring 2021 and recommended to the study coordinators to start its organization and announce it on the web page as soon as possible.</p> <p>A course about Teaching Science to Policy Makers may be offered during summer 2021.</p>
